

# SUMMER MATH SUPPORT

IXL is a comprehensive math review site with an unlimited number of math practice questions in hundreds of skills — all of which are aligned to state standards and common core state standards. One of the best things about IXL is that your child can access it from home, so you have a chance to see your child's progress!

To get your child started on your home computer, please follow these easy steps:

1. Go to [www.IXL.com/signin/mtviewixl](http://www.IXL.com/signin/mtviewixl) OR from the Mt View website, [http://schools.csd509j.net/mtn\\_view](http://schools.csd509j.net/mtn_view), click on **for kids** and then click on **IXL**
2. Sign-in under the username and password assigned
  - Username= student firstname and first initial of last name (no spaces)
  - Password= student firstname and first initial of last name (no spaces)

There are several ways you can use the program to practice math skills:

1. You can navigate to the **Practice** tab and choose the appropriate grade level.
  - Click on a skill to start practicing math.
  - Select a specific skill to practice from the list of skills. You can place your mouse over any skill to see a sample question and click on the link to begin.
2. You can navigate to the **State Standards** tab.
  - Find Oregon
  - Click on Oregon Common Core State Standards
  - You can look at your child's report card to find a standard that he/she might need to work on. Look at the skills listed under that standard and have your child begin practicing to build proficiency in those skills.
  - If your child is proficient in all grade level standards, then have him/her try to work on some skills from the grade above.

In addition to making math practice exciting, IXL is designed to help your child learn at his or her own pace. The website is adaptive and will adjust to your child's demonstrated ability level. The site also saves all of your child's results, so you can monitor your child's progress anytime by clicking on the **Reports** tab.

I hope you'll encourage your son or daughter to use IXL daily this summer.
