2017-18 Smarter Balanced Opt-out Notice

House Bill 2655 permits parents of students in grade 3-8 and 11 to annually opt-out of Oregon's statewide summative tests in English Language Arts and Math. To opt-out of one or both of these tests, you must complete the official 2017-18 Opt-out form and submit it to your child's school. Any student exempted from a state test will be provided with supervised study time while other students are testing. More information including the opt-out forms are located on the Corvallis School District website.

Cualquier estudiante exento de tomar este examen contará con supervisión durante sus estudios mientras el resto de los estudiantes están tomando dicho examen.
